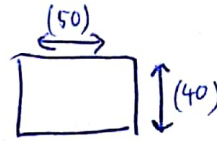


Pillow Case Tutorial

- 1) Measure the size of your pillow
* for example 50 cm x 40 cm



- 2) Cut 3 pieces of fabric

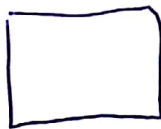
Nr 1) length of your pillow + 4 cm (example here; 54 cm total)
width of your pillow + 4 cm (44 cm)

Nr 2) half of length of pillow + 14 cm (25 + 14 = 39 cm)
width of your pillow + 4 cm (44 cm)

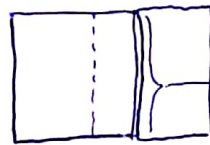
Nr 3) Same as Nr 2

You will create a pillow which looks like this;

front;



back;



overlining fabrics, is open, here you enter the pillow in the case

At the back you have two fabrics overlining each other in the middle, here you can push the pillow in. No buttons or velcro is needed.

- 3) Lay out Nr 1 with right side up.

Take fabric Nr 2, stitch a hemline folded to the wrong side on one of the short sides (fold 1 cm inside, and fold again another 1 cm)



it will look like this;



← short side

↑ long side

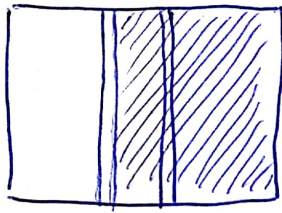
Do the same with fabric Nr. 3.

- 4) Now, on top of Nr 1; place Nr 2 aligned to the left with the wrong side up and the hemline pointing to the middle;

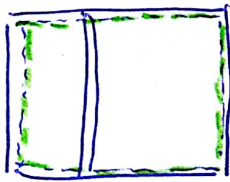


↑ hemline

- 5) On top of that place N3 with wrong side up, aligned to the right and with hem line pointing to the middle (2/3 are overlapping).



- 6) Sew all around the edges 1 cm from the sides;



- 7) Turn the case inside out. Ready! Push your pillow in.
