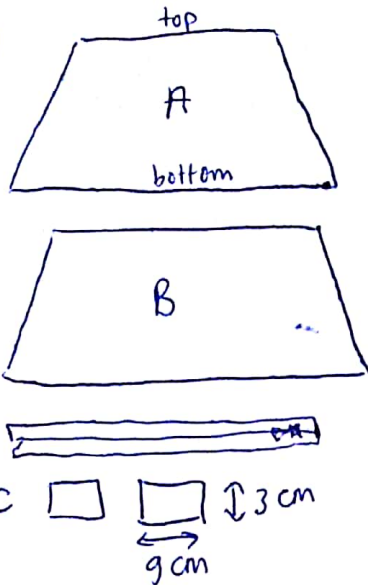


# Standing Zipperbag with lining



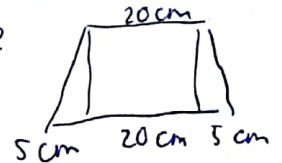
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①



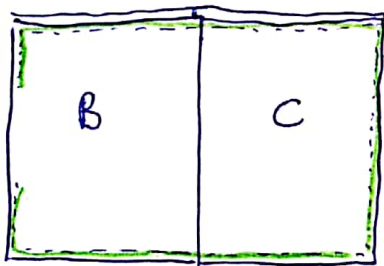
Cut your fabric. Cut the top of fabric A & B at the size of zipper + 2 cm longer. Cut the bottom of the fabric wider, you can play with it, start with a length  $\pm 10$  cm wider.

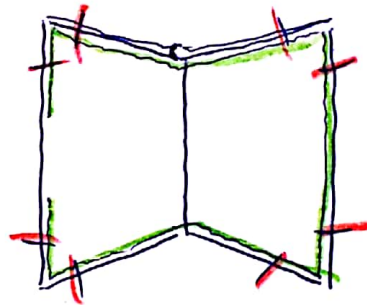

g<sup>A</sup>



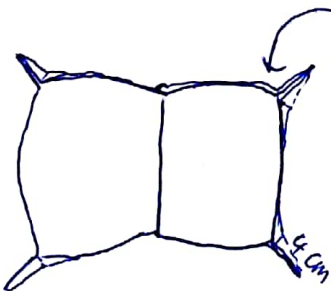
Sorry, it will look like this of course;



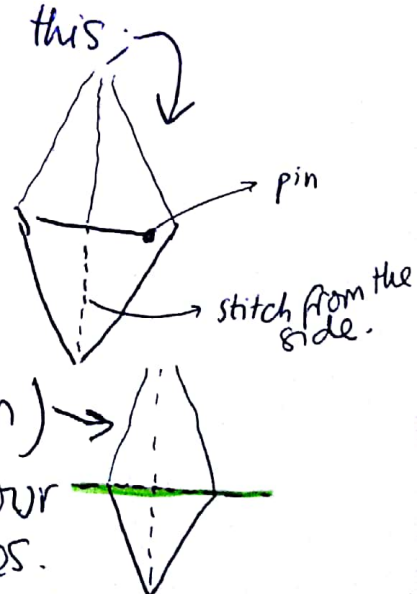
Put a pin 4 cm of all corners

g<sup>B</sup>

Align of each corner the side and the bottom seam so the pins on each side of a corner will touch each other.



if you look from here it looks like this: like your bags has small flaps on all sides.



g<sup>C</sup>

stitch these triangle corners 4 cm from the pointy end (where you placed the pin)

⑩ Cut off the triangle corners  $\frac{1}{2}$  cm from your stitchline. Trim all edges  $\frac{1}{2}$  cm from stitch lines. Don't trim the fabric where the whole is in B.
